Day 1: Arrive Melbourne airport

After arriving at the Melbourne international airport, continue to the car rental company desk to pick your car hired for self drive. Proceed to the hotel. Later, leave for sightseeing including the Eureka Skydeck 88 entry-

have a bird's view of the city, Melbourne cricket ground (tour between 10 a.m. - 3 p.m.) and the Melbourne aquarium – home to thousands of aquatic animals. The evening is scheduled for an unforgettable and unique dining experience on-board the Colonial Tramcar Restaurant, a restaurant on wheels. Relish your dinner and taste the best Australian wines while cruising along the streets of Melbourne. Admire the colonial-style interiors and the friendly service. Stay overnight in Melbourne.

Day 2: Melbourne - Mornington Peninsula

On day 2, post breakfast begin driving to Yarra Valley, a beautiful and lush valley, popular for its wines. Indulge in wine tasting at the well-known De Bortoli Wine Estate. Afterwards, continue your drive to Mornington Peninsula where you can indulge in a number of activities. Take a walk in the lush fields and relish juicy sunny ridge strawberries at the peninsula fields- Australia's largest producer of strawberries. Growing strawberries is the third generation business in the peninsular region. Next you explore the beautiful Ashcombe Maze & Lavender Gardens (25 acres of area) - the oldest and the most famous hedge maze and circular rose maze in Australia. Night stay in Mornington Peninsula.

Day 3: Mornington Peninsula - Warrnambool

Post breakfast on the 3rd day of the tour, you can opt for a tour of the Queenscliff Sorrento Ferry Service. This trip of 40-minutes is a link between the spectacular Bellarine Peninsula and Mornington Peninsula. Enjoy a view of this beautiful coastal region and spot the dolphins. The next attraction is Port Campbell National Park, popular for the twelve apostles and collection of wave-sculpted rock formations. Another major highlight is Loch Ard Gorge, a shipwreck 'loch ard' of the 19th century and the London Bridge. Take a walk along the shipwreck coast. Afterwards, drive along the picturesque Great Ocean road. After this, if you want then you can take a flight towards the bay of islands over the 12 apostles through the London Bridge or can simply take a walk on the shipwreck coast up till the Cape Otway Lighthouse. Night stay in Warrnambool.

Day 4: Warrnambool – Melbourne

Post breakfast on day 4, begin driving towards Melbourne. On the way take a halt to visit Ballarat, the sovereign hill a Gold Museum. Get back in time,

into the 1850s when affluent men and women, all dressed-up in the fineries and gold, walked down the street, showing-off their wealth. View the jaw-dropping collected of gold coins, artifacts and nuggets. Continue towards Melbourne. The evening is free for the activities of your interest. Stay overnight.

Day 5: Departure from Melbourne

Today is the last day of the tour when post a healthy breakfast, you receive an on-time transfer to the airport where you first return the car and later board a flight for your onward journey or can opt for an extension of your vacation.

DAY 01: Arrival in Perth

After you arrive at the Perth airport, get an assisted transfer to your pre-booked hotel. Once you complete the check-in formalities, spend the in doing the activities of your interest. Stay overnight in Perth.

DAY 03: Perth- Nambung National Park

On day 3, have your breakfast, and then explore the very well-known Nambung National Park to enjoy a great view of the Pinnacles Desert, home to exotic limestone spires. Enjoy a drive over the sand dunes here and interact with the wildlife, take pictures of the cute koalas. You can also try your hand at sand-boarding. Thereafter, you can visit a wildflower shop or enjoy swimming (Subject to weather condition). Stay overnight in Perth. (B)

DAY 04: Perth - Ayers Rock (around 6 hrs)

Once you have your breakfast, proceed to the airport to catch a flight to Ayers Rock. After arriving, check-in at your pre-booked hotel. Later, enjoy a tour to the Uluru-Kata Tjuta National Park to visit the Cultural Centre, take a stroll to the waterhole of Mutitjulu. Thereafter, have a guided tour of MalaWalk. You can also visit the traditional art sites to learn the geology and flora of the region. During sunset enjoy a complimentary glass of wine at Uluru. Relish open-air dinner under the stars, accompanied with champagne with the sound of the didgeridoo filling the air. Have a great view of the Kata Tjuta (the Olgas) and Uluru (Ayers Rock). DAY 05: Ayers Rock - Kings Canyon (4.5 hours)

Get up early today to have a great view of the sunrise at Uluru. Post tea/coffee, enjoy the enchanting sight. After breakfast, proceed to the western area of Uluru-Kata Tjuta National Park where you arrive at the gigantic 36 -rock domes of Kata Tjuta. Have a guided walk into Walpa (Olga) Gorge and admire the beauty sprinkled all around. In the afternoon, proceed to the stunning Kings Canyon in the Watarrka National Park. Overnight stay in Kings Canyon. (B)

DAY 06: King Canyon - Alice Springs

Post breakfast on day 6, continue to the outstanding formations of Kings Canyon. You can opt for a guided walk along the rim walk that takes you to the canyon rim, passing through the Lost City towards the Garden of Eden. However, to embark on this walk, you need to be extremely fit. Finally, you arrive at the canyon floor walk where you reach the towering orange walls. In the afternoon, begin travelling to Alice Springs. Halt at the Kings Creek Station, an outback cattle/ camel station. This station is the largest exporter of wild camels in Australia, which it sells for various purposes. Stay overnight in Alice Springs. (B)

DAY 07: Alice Springs

Post breakfast, you get a chance to explore Alice Springs –once-in-a-lifetime experience. This place is most popular outback town of the world. Here you can have an insight into the region's history and wildlife too. This place is the spiritual heart of Australia's Red Centre Overnight stay in Alice Springs. (B)

DAY 08: Departure

Today is the last day of your tour when you get transferred to the airport to board a flight for your next destination.

Day 1:(Arrival at Brisbane)

Filled with around 50 fast paced rides and magnificent attractions of 8 different countries, Dreamworld is Australia's biggest. Starting with the rides, guests can indulge in the watery family rides (River rapids, Log ride), special rides for kids and at last the series of thrill rides; they prefer to call the 'BIG 9' (Giant Drop, Buzz Saw, Tower of Terror).

Besides these high speed rides, you can get yourself busy in sunset safari, croc feeding, wildlife photography and tiger feeding. Don't forget to meet your favorite animated characters from movies like King Fu Panda, Madagascar and Shrek come alive at the DreamWorks experience section.

Overnight in Gold Coast.

Day 03: (Fun continues at Gold Coast)

This tiny paradise is also a home of exotic species of wildlife; especially birds. Right at the foothills of Barron Gorge national park in the rainforest lies the Tjapukai Aboriginal Cultural Park. The park offers an excellent opportunity to immerse it in to the traditional culture of the Aborigines. You can even learn throwing boomerang or didgeridoo playing from them.

Post this rainforest trip, guests would be transferred to a pre-booked hotel at Cairns for an overnight stay.

Lunch and dinner at Indian restaurant.

Day 05: (Cairns)

Your tour of the beautiful city of Cairns will start early in the morning by a Hot Balloon ride. A perfect way to kick start the day, this aerial ride will offer you a breathtaking sight of some of the most panoramic landscapes on the planet. Post that, relish a yummy breakfast at the countryside of Cairns.

Located off the coast of Queensland, Great Barrier Reef is the world's largest coral reef system. In order to explore the exotic marine life created by the corals, snorkeling is the best. However, guests need to pay an additional cost to try their hand in that watersport and even for swimming. You can also opt for a supervised beginner level scuba dive here.

After all this action, call it a day and return to your hotel for an overnight stay in Cairns.

Lunch onboard the cruise and dinner at an Indian restaurant.

Day 06: (Cairns-Sydney)

Post an early breakfast, check out from the hotel and leave to catch the flight to Sydney. Upon your arrival at Sydney, you would be transferred to a

Itinerary Details

Day 1: Departure (flight to Brisbane)

Get ready for an amazing memorable tour of Australia- 'The Land Down Under'. Board your overnight flight to Brisbane.
